Printed visuals that guide students and reduce repeated questions

How to Use Project Sheets

- These are visual guides to remind students of the main building steps and the materials needed.
- Project sheets can reduce repeated questions such as, “What do I do next?” This allows you to focus on more meaningful interactions and supporting learning.
- Project sheets **do not** replace instruction. You will still need to guide students on how to build the project at the beginning of the lesson, explain the key concepts, and connect the activity to your learning goals.

Suggested Setup

- Color print 1 project sheet per 2-3 kids. Laminate them for longevity.
- Spread them out on the work tables.
- When kids ask questions that can be answered by the project sheet, direct them to use their observational skills to see if they can find the answer themselves.
